New Tuition Rates Set for 2024-25

The VGP Parent Advisory Board approved new tuition rates for the upcoming school year. We are offering class on MWF mornings and afternoons and TuTh mornings or afternoons. Tuition may be paid monthly, but there is a discounted rate (~3%) for those who wish to pay every three months (quarterly.) These rates reflect a pricing structure to accommodate a wider variety of offerings. Quarterly payments are due by April 12th (for Sept., Oct. & Nov.), November 1 (for Dec., Jan & Feb.), and February 1 (for March, April & May.)



The first payment for all children presently enrolled for the fall is due no later than April 12th to reserve your child's place for the 2024-25 school year. Any parent who needs to make special arrangements for tuition should speak to Karen as soon as possible.

Unfortunately, we are unable to hold a child's place for next year without receipt of this first tuition payment by April 12th.

*Please note that all fees and tuition payments are non-refundable.

For parents who wish to have payments sent automatically to the preschool - you can set it up through your bank or you can pay via Venmo. If you use Venmo, we request that you add 2% to cover the associated fees..

Field Days



However, you will need to provide or arrange your child's transportation to and from the farm. <u>If your child will be</u> <u>attending without a parent, please let Karen know as soon as</u> <u>possible</u> - your child will be specifically assigned to one of the teachers for their session. Please let Karen know how many adults and siblings (preschool age) will be attending with you so we can provide the farm with attendance numbers.

For students who attend all day or attend both Th. and Fri., you have the option of having your child attend as many sessions as you wish. Please confirm this with Karen
